Parent Guide to Remote Learning

Student will be expected to follow their normal timetable of lessons.
All lessons, resources and student activities can be accessed via Microsoft Teams.

Teams Lessons will be 50 mins long to allow time to set up for the next lesson.

Year 8, 10 and 11

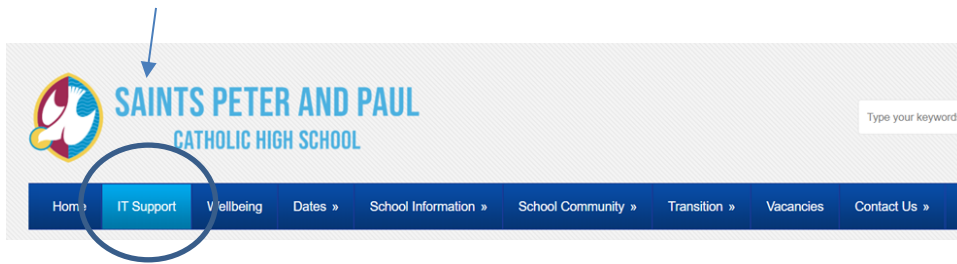

Format of remote learning lessons

- Lessons will last for 50 minutes and all students are expected to attend and complete work.
- Teachers will provide explicit instruction and explanation for students during the lesson. This will be either through
 - A live lesson, students can find the link to join the lesson in their calendar on Teams
 - Instructions posted in chat on class Team
- All lesson resources will be saved in class Team and students will work independently on tasks and will have the opportunity to ask questions or get additional support from the teacher, by using the chat function during the lesson
- Please note that for PE there will be an activity posted in the files and not a live lesson.
- Please note that when a member of staff is absent there will be no live lesson but work will still be posted in Teams for students to complete
- Some lessons will require students to submit work through assignments.

Guidance for parents

- Build a schedule for your child as continuing the structure of the school day will help your child to learn
