- 100% 'September guarantee'. We are extremely proud of this considering the backdrop of school closing for lockdown and no physical contact from January 2021. This meant that every student in Year 11 had been made an offer of learning for September 2021 before they left our school.
- An increase in the number of students accessing level 3 courses (1.6% increase from last year). This trend has increased by 5.8% since 2018.
- Pupil Premium students accessing level 3 courses increased from the previous year (0.6% increase). The increase since 2018 has been 9.4%.
- The number of 'More Able/High Achievers' accessing level 3 courses increased by 1.6%. This has increased by 6.9% since 2018.
- The number of More Able students who are 'Pupil Premium' accessing level 3 courses increased by 0.9% on last year (and has increased by 11.8% since 2018).
- The number of SEND students accessing level 3 provision increased by 1.3%. SEND data has been consistent since 2018.
